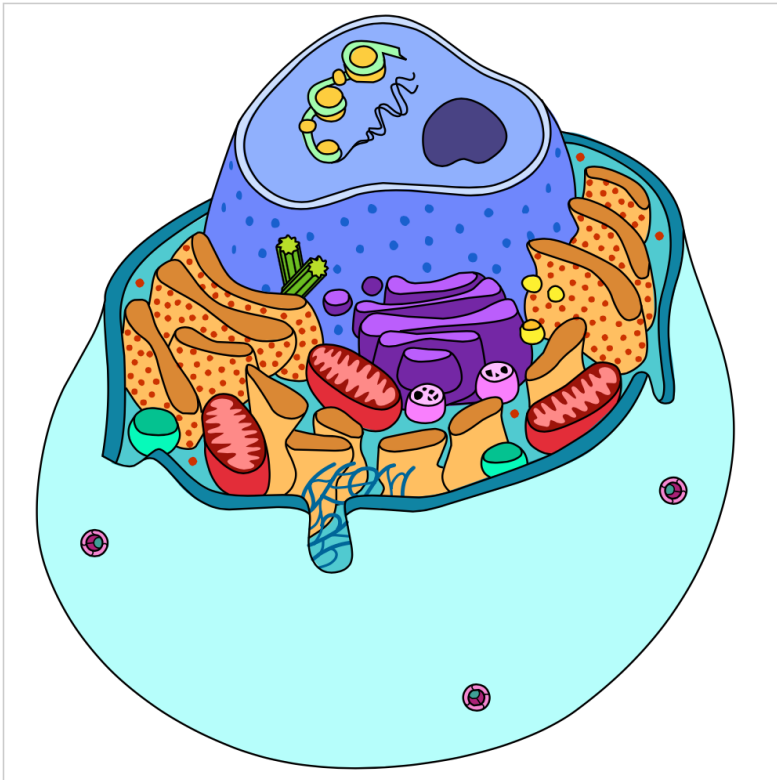

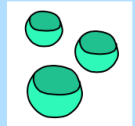
Nuclear DNA (Animal)

Correct! DNA (Deoxyribonucleic Acid) contains the genetic information for cells to grow, live, perform their functions, and reproduce.



Peroxisome (Animal)

Correct! These collect and safely break down chemicals that are toxic to the cell.



Cytoskeleton (Animal)

Correct! Made up of filaments and tubules, the cytoskeleton helps shape and support the cell. It also helps move things around in the cell. For artistic purposes, the cytoskeleton is shown in just one place when in reality it is found throughout the cell.
